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Reds

Woolloomooloo, Shiraz, Australia, 2014

7 22

Woolloomooloo is a suburb of Sydney associated with sheep farming. This Shiraz is rich and mellow with a hint of vanilla oak and spice. Very well balanced.

Bodegas y Vinedos Merayo Mencia, Bierzo, Spain 2013

10 30

The key to the Merayo wines are the ancient Mencia bush vines. Even the entry level wine is made from 80 year old vineyards. All vineyards are handpicked. This red has all the fresh, perfumed characters and ripe red fruit typical of Mencia. Juicy red fruits, notes of violets and spices. Rich, fresh and creamy with good length on the finish.

Pinot Noir, Calusari, Viile Timisului, Romania 2013

Is there anything better than Pinot Noir! It's an incredibly fussy and temperamental grape and it only grows well in certain corners of the world, This Pinot Noir will be a revelation to any serious Pinot Noir drinker! With its cool climate, Romania is becoming a source for wines with great acidity & fresh fruit character. This style of wine is light enough to compliment rich fish dishes.

Primitivo, Syrah Laghiglione IGP Puglia, Italy, 2013

24

This Primitivo has been aged in oak vats before bottling. Rich and soft with notes of blackberries and spice, this brambly red is made from the grape also known as Zinfandel.

Soligamar Rioja Reserva, Spain, 2009 **49**

Rioja is probably the best value wine region around, wines aren't released until they are at their required level of maturity so they are always ready to drink. This Rioja is made from a blend of 75% Tempranillo, 20% Garnacha and 5% Mazuelo grapes from well established low yielding vineyards in the high altitudes of Rioja Baja. The wine is then aged in oak for 25 months producing a lovely Reserva style of Rioja.

Crozes Hermitage, Olivier Ravoire, Rhône, France, 2010 **46**

100% Syrah, truly representative of the land situated on the left bank of the Rhône, in the Drome department. The vineyards develop their full potential and maturity drawing from the rocky soil and white pebbles. Full of pepper and spice expression.

Altas Cumbres Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina, 2013 **26**

A soft yet vibrant Malbec produced in the foothills of the Andes. Plenty of ripe, red berry fruit enhanced by a few months ageing in French and American oak. The palate is round and velvety smooth.

Glenelly Cabernet Sauvignon, Stellenbosch, South Africa, 2012 **31**

The Glenelly estate offer Bordeaux-inspired structure with New World richness; Classic cassis flavours with hints of cherry and dark chocolate harmoniously combined with 12 months of oak maturation producing a classy, opulent wine.

Privilège Merlot, France, 2013 **22**

A really concentrated Merlot from the south of France with good colour and a pronounced bouquet. The Privilege wines are the best that Drouet produces.

Primitivo di Manduria, Puglia, Italy, 2013 **33**

Hints of smokiness in this bouquet and a rich cask aged fullness in this strong but soft southern Italian wine. Manduria is the only village to have its own DOC for the Primitivo grape.

Dados Reserva, Messias, Douro, Portugal, 2009 **43**

The Douro valley in the north of Portugal produces some of the countries finest wines. This excellent very full bodied Reserva wine is made from the same grapes used to produce Port.

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Bubbles

Domenico de Bertiol Prosecco di Valdobbiadene Spumante, Italy **6** **30**

A famous Prosecco used in world-renowned Harry's Bar, Venice, where the Bellini was invented. Tiny, pinpoint bubbles explode with green apple, pear and candied peel, all enveloped in a creamy mouthfeel.

Canard-Duchêne Brut, Champagne, France NV **48**

A harmonious blend of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay gives this Champagne a beautifully clean and fresh character, the palate has subtle toasty notes with plenty of fresh fruit and apple tart undertones, what's not to adore about it.

Whites

Sauvignon Blanc, Terres Fumées, France, 2014 **9** **26**

Classic French Sauvignon Blanc. Zesty citrus with white stone fruits and hints of gooseberry rolling in to a full, textured palate. A clean refreshing finish.

Grand Cape Chardonnay, South Africa, 2014 **6** **19**

Unoaked and fresh with orange, citrus and tropical flavours, rounded off with honey and lemon zest. Utterly gluggable!

Terrazze della Luna Pinot Grigio, Trentino, Italy, 2014 **7 22**

There is a reason why Pinot Grigio is so popular and taking the world by storm. Stone fruit, apple and floral on the nose. A delicate yet complex mouthful of blossom, refreshing minerality and attractive white fruit, building to fresh citrus acidity on the finish.

Domaine de Vedilhan Viognier, Pays d'Oc, Languedoc, France, 2013 **20**

Viognier from the South of France is a wine lovers dream. Viognier ripen really easily and loves the sun, so it produces wonderfully fruity and fragrant wines. Vivacious peach, mango and apricots, complimented by delicate and flirtatious rose and honeysuckle. A luscious, rounded, and silky smooth body.

Colla Langhe Riesling, Poderi Colla, Piemonte, Italy, 2013 **38**

Riesling is without doubt the most misunderstood grape in the wine world. It can be sweet, however most examples are dry. A rare and stunning example with lime cordial, steely freshness and delicate floral notes. This isn't your ballsy Aussie or petrol-laden German Riesling – this is grown-up, powerful and refined

The Cup and Rings Albarino, Rias Baixas, Spain , 2013 **35**

Albariño is grown in the North-West and is adored by locals with fresh seafood, Made by no other than a Master of Wine, this is a showstopper. Pronounced peach, honeysuckle and stone fruits with a creamy mouthfeel. Sometimes exhibits a playful spritzzy 'tang' on the tongue.

Mesta Verdejo, Bodegas Fontana, Uclés, Spain (Organic), 2014 **19**

Named after the Mesta, a powerful alliance of sheep ranchers in medieval Castile in central Spain; Enticing aromas of white pepper and fennel on the nose with a dry, herbaceous palate, fresh and unoaked and great balance on the finish..

Montagny 1er Cru Montcuchots Tastevine, France, 2011 **47**

Francoise Feuillat Juillot produces one of the best wines in the Burgundy village of Montagny. This wine has the fullness of good white Burgundy enhanced by a few months in oak cask and has been awarded the coveted Tasteviné label for top quality.

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Roses

La Sonriza Rosé, Ile de Beaute, Corsica, Italy, 2014 **21**

A delicious fruity dry rosé from the island of Corsica with a light salmon pink colour.

Terreo Malbec Rose, Comté Tolosan, France, 2014 **24**

This rosé captures the richness of the Malbec grape with hints of strawberry fruit flavours and a lovely crisp refreshing acidity.
